# KEY ELEMENTS OF THE SPORTS INDUSTRY PROGRAM

1. **Strength and Conditioning** - the undertaking of activities based around health and fitness in the high performance centre through classes.
2. **Skill Development and Competition** – SIP students receive an \$80 credit towards any sports academy. Students can be involved in as many academies as they like. It is expected that SIP students are involved in at least one. It is also expected that students take on opportunities through the year with our inter school and in house sports competitions.
3. **Community Links** - Students work with the community as college representatives. This may be volunteering at primary school athletics days or running SIP sessions for primary school students. This has provided students with ongoing opportunities outside of school and is a great way to boost experience in sports industries.
4. **Sports Industry Education** - completion of certificate III in Sport and Recreation over two years (Years 10, 11 or 12). All students explore higher education options in sport through links with Deakin University and other affiliations. All SIP students are introduced to greater opportunities beyond secondary school.

**The Sports Industry Program requires all students adhere to the following:**

- Maintain a level of at least 70% effort across all subjects.
- Wear the SIP uniform proudly and appropriately including **ONLY** on the days you have a double period of your SIP subject or an inter school sports day.
- Be involved in each SIP class and program events to the best of your ability and participate in school sports opportunities as much as possible.
