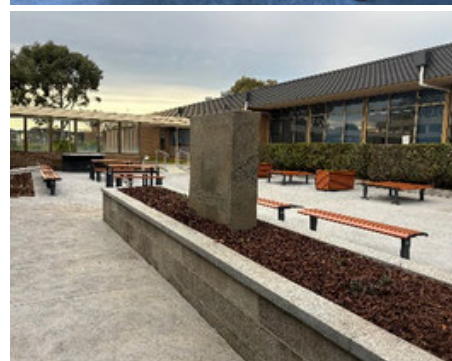
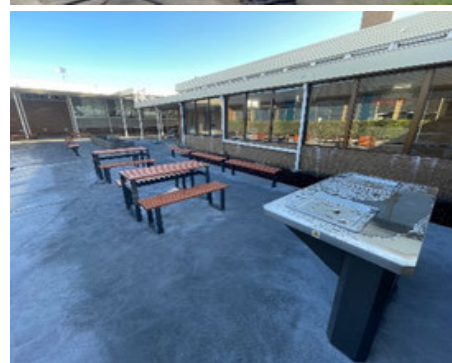
PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

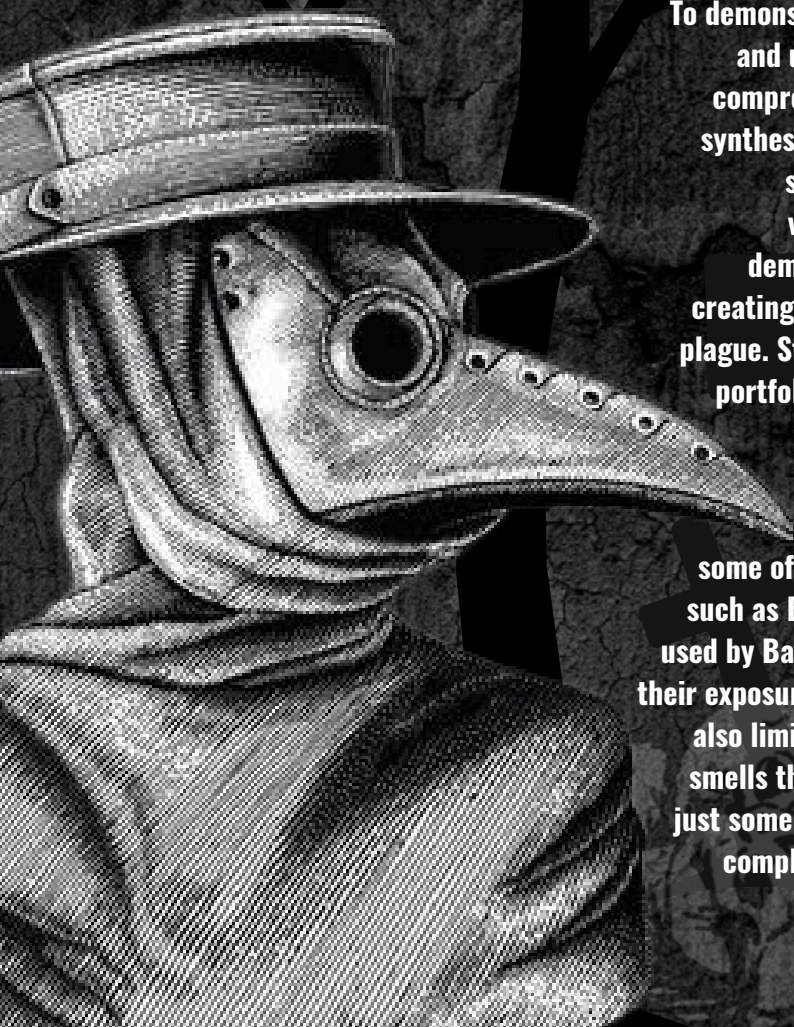
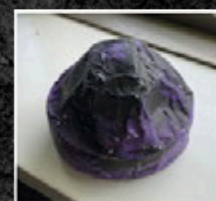
BLACK PLAGUE

Students have learned about the types of the plague, crazy cures used to treat the plague and the eventual decline and death of 1 in 3 people through Europe and England.

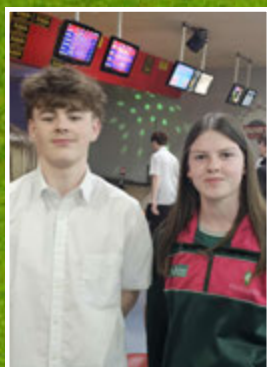
